Combination not to have won 2 firsts in a dressage test at prelim level in the last 12 months.

CLASS 9 COMBINED TRAINING - BD NOVICE 34 (2009) revised 2016 - 70CM (APPROX 2'3)

Restrictions: Classes 1 and 3: No combinations that have competed at Affiliated British Dressage – including on tickets

Rosettes: To 6th place, more if entries warrant.

Veterans: There will be a rosette for the highest placed veteran horse in every class. Horses must be aged 19 years and over to be eligible. (Please state horse's age in the Entrants notes).

CVRC Initiative: 2 extra marks will be awarded in all classes for tests in which a correctly fitted plain Cavesson noseband is used. In light of recent scientific studies highlighting the welfare issues raised by the overtightening of nosebands, we have decided to encourage the use of correctly fitted plain Cavesson nosebands. Other dressage legal nosebands e.g. flash, drop etc, can of course still be used, but no extra marks will be given.
